Hospital Information: Patients of Eagle family physicians who require hospitalization are admitted and followed by the Triad Hospitalists (board-certified internists). communication among the family physicians and the hospitalists are excellent. Hospital admissions are at Moses Cone, or Wesley Long both of which are part of the Cone Health System. At the 2 Cone hospitals in Greensboro, there is a comprehensive range of secondary and tertiary level diagnostic and treatment services and 800+ beds. The family medicine residency program at Cone is affiliated with UNC Medical Center - Chapel Hill.

Community Information: Greensboro is a city of 300,000 people, with a regional

population

of approximately 1.6 million. Greensboro is located in the central "Piedmont" area of North Carolina, within easy driving distance of both the mountains and the beach via Interstate 40 and

several other major highways. There is a four-season climate (winter is very short and moderate!) The Piedmont Triad International airport in Greensboro has 6 different airlines and 65+ flights daily, direct to major cities in the East, South and Midwest.
